Executive Director Nathalie Molliet-Ribet gave an overview of the meeting agenda and provided an introduction to the staff study of the Marcus alert system.

Claire Mairead briefed members on the Marcus alert system in Virginia. She briefly discussed the requirements and goals of Marcus Alert as laid out in statute and local plans and spoke about the implementation status of Marcus Alert across in Virginia. Claire also discussed funding awarded by the General Assembly and provided several options and recommendations to improve the distribution of those funds. Claire discussed findings about the effectiveness of Marcus Alert in areas of the state where it has been implemented and offered options and recommendations to help achieve the system's full potential. Lastly, Claire listed some recommendations that the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services should implement to improve the Marcus alert system.
